



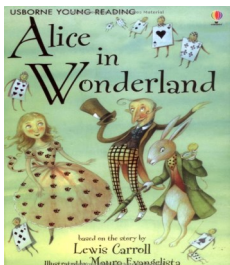

English:

Texts drivers: Alice in Wonderland

We will be writing a new problem into the story of Alice in Wonderland and writing the solution. We will then be writing formal invites to the Mad Hatter's Tea Party as well as writing a job description.

Maths:

Our lessons this half term will be focused on multiplication and division, shape, volume and capacity and mental maths skills.

Science: This half term we will be continuing to investigate how plants grow. We will look at different types of seeds and bulbs and the key things they need in order to grow healthily.



History:

During history, we will be learning about the lives of significant queens from the past who have contributed to national achievements: Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II



DT:

During DT we will be using our cutting, rolling and decorating skills to produce a coronation gingerbread biscuit.

PSHE: We will start the half term with our 'My Happy Minds' module entitled 'Engage'. After this, we will be learning about economic wellbeing.

RE: This half term our focus is on 'Special Places'. Within this we will be looking at the importance of Synagogues to people of Jewish faith.

PE: This term we will be developing our striking and fielding skills as well as learning about athletics.

Wider learning at home

We encourage the children to **read 4 times a week** at home, as well as practising their spellings and number bonds.

You could also:

- Draw a portrait of either Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria or Queen Elizabeth II.
- Create a family tree for Queen Elizabeth II.
- Create a fact file on one of the 3 queens.
- Plot the 3 queens on a timeline.
- Make a crown and sceptre from junk modelling.
