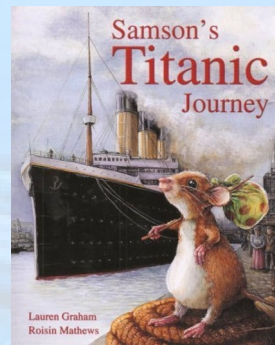
Art

We will be learning about 2 passengers on board the Titanic who were from Basingstoke.



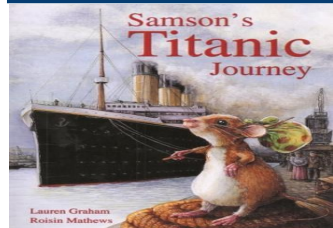

English:

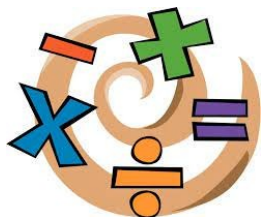
Text drivers: Samson's Titanic Journey, Sensational

We will be writing letters home to Samson's family at different points in his journey.

We will be writing poems in role as Samson on board the Titanic.

Maths:

Our lessons this half term will be focused on the skills of addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, measurement and geometry.



Science: Humans growing up

We will be looking at healthy lifestyles and life cycles.



History:

We will learn about the Titanic: an event beyond living memory that is nationally significant.

Later in the half term, we will also learn about how the disaster affected the local Basingstoke community.

Art:

We will be focusing on patterns and printing, looking at the work of William Morris. We will be print patterns in the style of this artist that could have featured on curtains aboard Titanic.

RE:

Our focus this half term is on the Jewish festival, Purim. We will be learning what it is and its importance to the Jewish community.

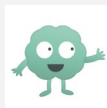
PE: This half term we will be developing our team work skills during our teacher PE lessons. We will also continue to develop our hockey skills during our sessions with our sports coach.
