



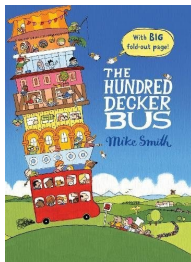

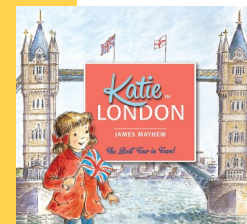

We will begin by writing narratives with a specific focus on descriptive language. After this, we will move on to retelling the story of 'Katie in London'.

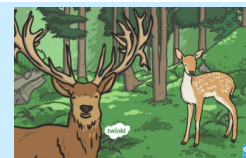


Maths:
