Here are things that will be different:



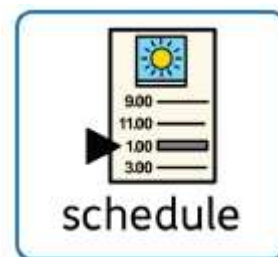
- the children in your class

The things that we will probably do on the first day back:

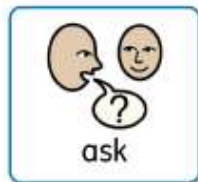

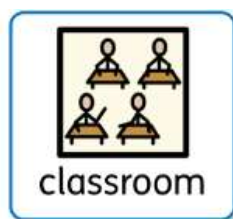
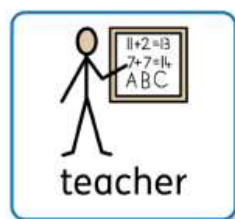
But most importantly, have fun!
