Here are things that will stay the same:



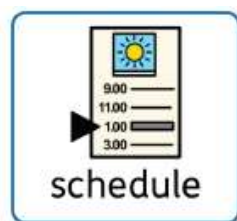

Here are things that will be different:

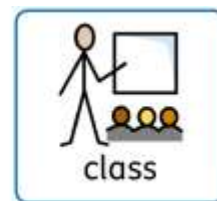


- Your teacher and LSA's.

- PE may be on a different day.

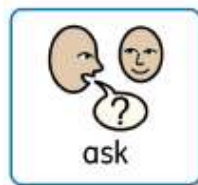
The things that we will probably do on the first day back:



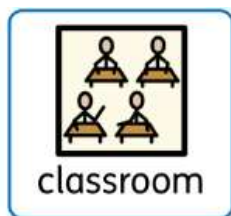
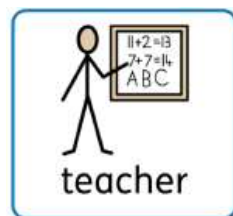
We will make sure everyone feels calm and happy as well as comfortable in their new classrooms. We will share news from our summer holidays as well as the expectations for year 1.
