Maths:

PSHE: Respecting ourselves and others

This half term in PSHE, children will focus on respecting themselves and others, exploring topics such as positive relationships, personal boundaries, and peer pressure.

PE: This term we will be developing our Athletics and Tennis skills.



Science: Living things and their habitats

Children will learn about living things and their habitats, exploring how different plants and animals are suited to the environments they live in. They will investigate how habitats provide what living things need to survive.



Wider Curriculum Opportunities

Continent in a Box

Children create a **shoebox scene** representing a continent.

- Include landmarks, animals, climate, and people
- Use craft materials (cardboard, fabric, LEGO, natural materials)
- Add moving parts (e.g. swinging monkey, erupting volcano)

Build a Home Around the World

Create a model of a **typical home**:

- Igloo (Antarctica)
- Stilt house (Asia)
- Mud hut (Africa)

Discuss through making: Why is it built that way?

Nature Art – Continent Collage

Use natural or recycled materials to create a **textured collage**:

- Sand for deserts
- Leaves for jungles
- Cotton wool for polar regions

Focus on **texture and colour**, not writing.
