My teachers will be Miss Thain.

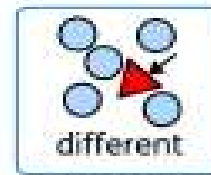
My LSA will be Mrs Hardy.

Here are things that will stay the same:



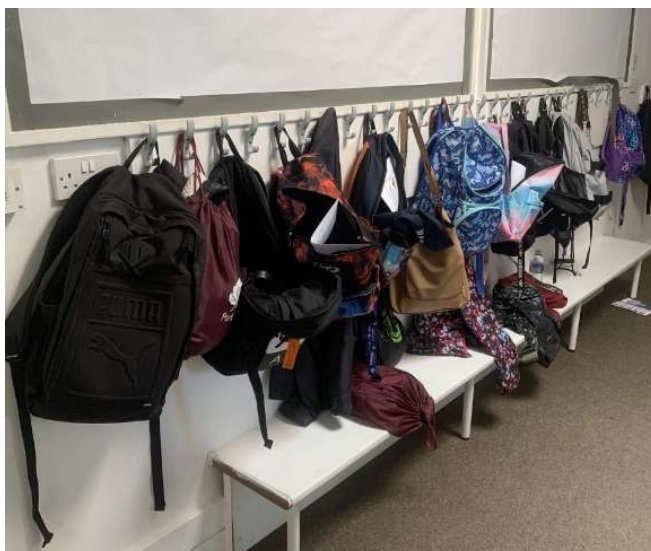
- Mrs Owens will be our Head Teacher

Here are things that will be different:

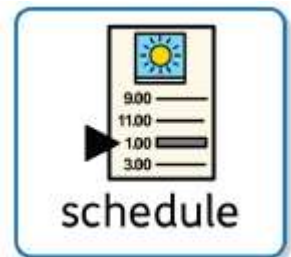


- Miss Thain will be your teacher and you will be in Oak Class.

The things that we will probably do on the first day back:



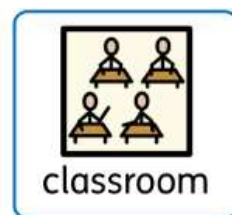
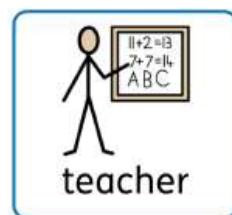
- Discuss expectations of behaviour in the classroom.
