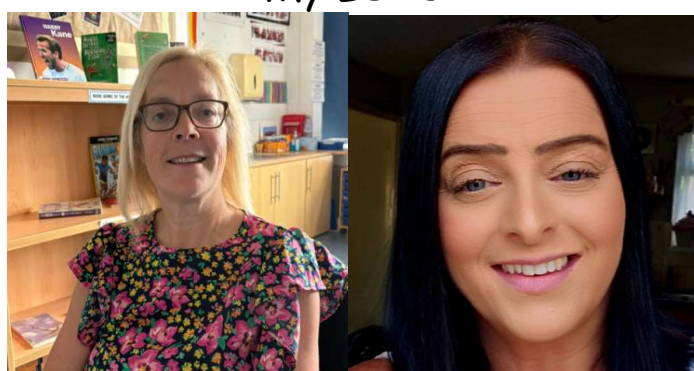

My LSAs will be Mr Keeping and Mrs Kelly.

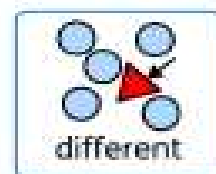
Here are things that will stay the same:



- Mrs Owens will be our Head Teacher

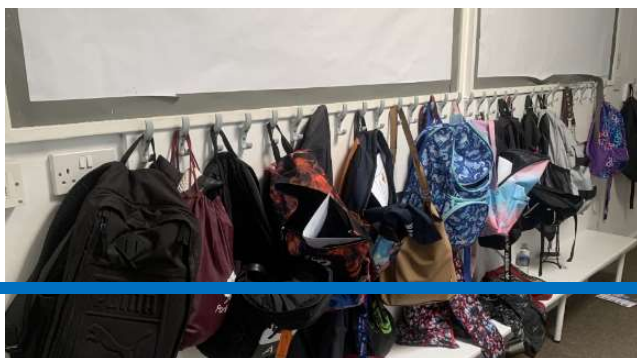
- I will know most of the children in my class

Here are things that will be different:



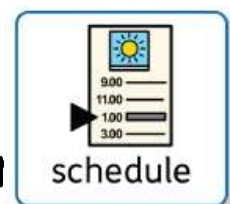
- Mr Dale will be your teacher and you will be called Sycamore Class.

Where I can put my things:

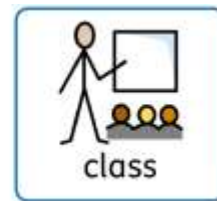




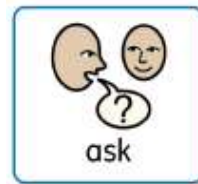
The things that we will probably do on the first day back:



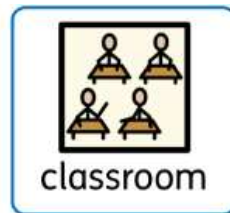
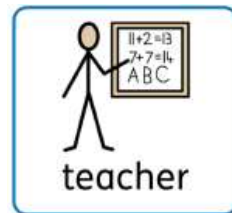
- Discuss expectations of behaviour in the classroom
