



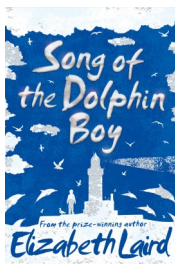
Can We Change Our Future?

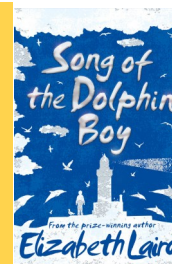

English:

Texts driver—Song of a Dolphin Boy by Elizabeth Laird

Inspired by the book, we will write: descriptions of the sea, our own endings of a chapter and a non-chronological report about our own sea creature. Finally, we will write a formal letter presenting our opinions on climate change.



Maths:

Number and place value & addition and subtraction using formal written methods.

Science: Sound

We will investigate how sound travels and learn the different parts of the ear and their functions.



Geography:

We will learn about different types of weather, both in the UK and around the world. We will look at how climate change is effecting the planet and what it might mean for the future.

ICT: We Are Meteorologists

We will be exploring the use of ICT to record weather

Art:

We will learn about the artist Jonathan Woodward and be inspired by his illustrations to create images of sea creatures. To help us, we will explore drawing techniques and the use of watercolours.

PSHE: Our focus for Autumn term is 'Healthy Lifestyles'.

We will be looking at our mental health and wellbeing.

My Happy Mind: Meet Your Brain.

RE -Myths: We will learn about myths from around the world, focussing on Hindu myths. We will look at how the myth of 'Rama and Sita' play a central role in the festival of Diwali.

PE: This term we will be developing our Football and teamwork skills.



Wider learning at home

- Choose 2 places around the world and look at the weather forecast, how are they similar/different?
