- I will use different toilets.

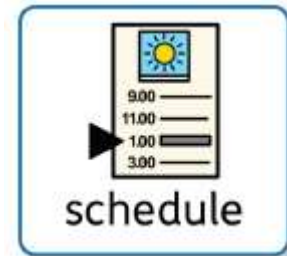
Where I can put my things:

- You will also have a tray in the classroom for your things.



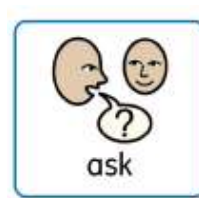
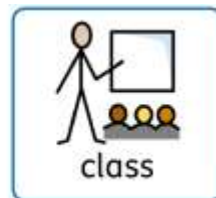
The things that we will probably do on the first day back:

You will also:

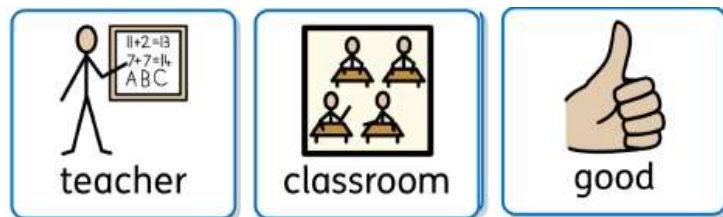
- Explore the classroom
