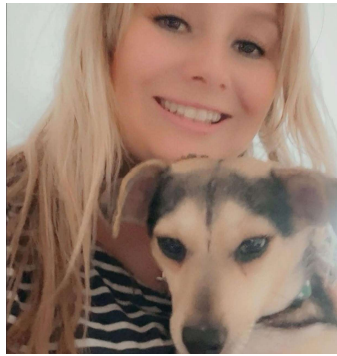


Starting my new class

My LSA will be Mrs Dawes.

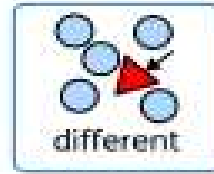


Here are things that will stay the same:

Here are things that will be different:



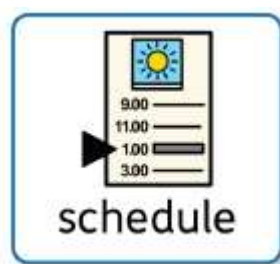
- Miss Howson will be my teacher and we will be called Willow Class

- We will each get a locker to put our things in!

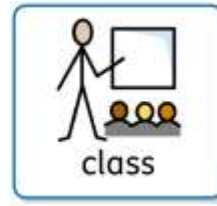
Where I can put my things:



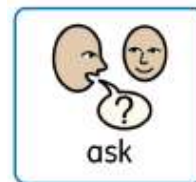
The things that we will probably do on the first day back:

- Discuss our hobbies and interests

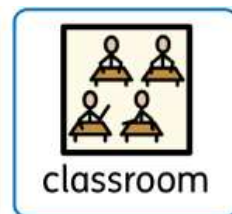
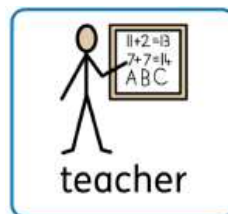




Lots of children feel worried and maybe excited when they are starting something new. It is ok to ask questions. Your teacher and teaching assistants will help you.
