My LSA will be Miss Putt.

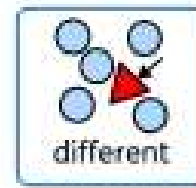
Here are things that will stay the same:

Here are things that will be different:



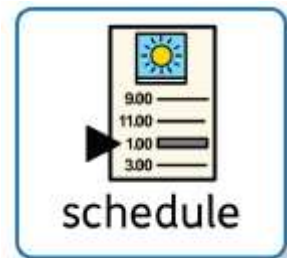
- My teacher's names will be Mrs Pfende.

Where I can put my things:

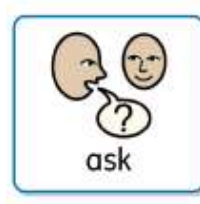
- On the pegs outside our classroom - I will be given a peg on the first day after the summer holiday.

During the first couple of days back we will be doing lots of exciting activities and games that will help us get to know each other and help you know what to do in Year 3. You will also:

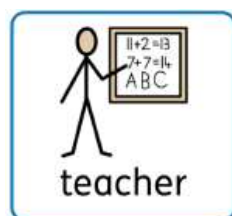


- Explore the classroom.
