

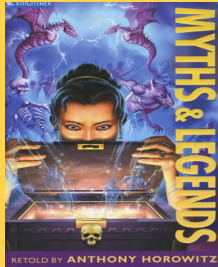
What Did The Greeks Do For Me?

Texts drivers: **Myths & Legends** by Anthony Horowitz

We will be looking at a range of stories from Greek mythology and then using these to inspire us when we write myths of our own. We will then create our own recipes for a Greek-inspired dish.

Maths:

Multiples, factors, cube and square numbers. Coordinates. Multi-step problems.



Science — Life Cycles:

We will be learning about the life cycles of different types of animals, including mammals, amphibians, birds and fish.

History — Ancient Greece:

We will learn about some aspects and legacies of the Ancient Greek Civilisations, including theatre and philosophy.

We will also look at how historians consider the significance of people, events and ideas.



RE — Sacred Places:

We will places of worship, particularly mosques .

PSHE — Living in the wider world:

We will be learning about shared responsibilities that we all have.

PE: This term we will be developing our athletic skills and learning about games that Ancient Greek citizens competed in.

BSL: This term's BSL unit is 'Family' and will focus on people, pets and ages.
