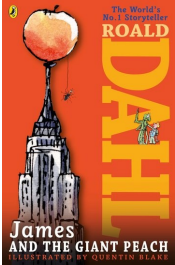

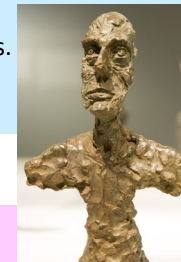


Maths: Fractions and Geometry/Addition and Subtraction

Science: Rocks and Fossils

Children begin an identifying, grouping and classifying enquiry to group rocks based on their simple properties.

Practical activities such as observing actual rocks, will allow children to describe their properties.



History:

We will enter the Bronze Age and finish with the Iron Age. In particular we will be looking at the homes, tools and food.



RE:

We will be learning about the Hindu festival of Holi—the stories and celebrations.

Art/DT:

We will look Alberto Giacometti and Leonardo Da Vinci's work of the human body artwork and look at how they differ and what are the similarities.
