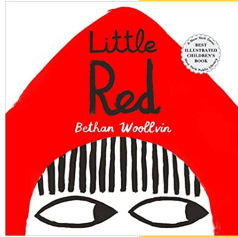

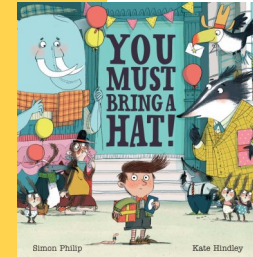


English:
