



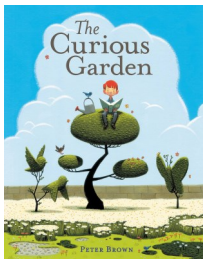
What makes our garden grow?

English:

Texts drivers: Pattan's Pumpkin, The Night Gardener

We will be writing a character description of The Night gardener and creating our own story using Pattan's Pumpkin as our focus.

Maths:

Geometry, fractions with multiplication and division, and measurement: time, capacity and volume

Science: Plants: How do plants grow? Seed/bulb to flower and how they need water, light and warmth

Geography:

The children will be introduced to the word biome.

ART:

We will be looking at drawing and collage.
